




The week started off with our Day 1 activity of Poster Making and hedged off with Diwali Celebration.

Begin again, to keep trying.






This is the watchtower of our school. It is like the big ben of our school. It is near the dining hall. It helps us keep track of time.





THE COMMON ROOM


COMMON ROOM WHERE ALL OF US SPEND OUR FREE TIME


This is the clock tower. It shows the time. It is the prominent place at The Sagar School.




